Abstract: This side event will invite youth representatives, scholars, business representatives, and experts to discuss how youth can promote innovation, participate in climate governance and contribute to global sustainable development.

This side event will invite the audience to participate through targeted invitations and random invitations. Targeted invitations will mainly invite governments and United Nations agencies and partners, such as the Chinese government and foreign governments through their embassies in China; UNDP, UNWOMEN, UNEP, and UNICEF are invited through their branches in China; overseas NGOs, think tanks; business associations and enterprises. At the same time, the media organizations will prepare a press release in both Chinese and English in advance and promote it through domestic and international media, including China Daily, China Net, etc., and international media jointly formulated through collaboration.

It is jointly organized by the C Team, the China Association for NGO Cooperation (CANGO), and the China Sustainability Tribune.
